Not sure which class your koi are in? Just enter the number of fish you are bringing on the "Not Classified" line above in the size column for each approximate length and we will help you classify them at the show during benching. It is important to record a good estimate of your koi lengths in order to reasonably calculate your estimated fish load so we can ensure that there are enough tanks to safely accommodate all of the koi entered in the show. If a tank is overloaded you will be asked to remove one or more koi.

To calculate the Total Estimated Load, add the number of fish of each size and enter in the Size Totals. Multiply Size Totals by the Load Factor by Size and enter in Load by Size. Add the Load by Size numbers and enter as the Total Estimated Load.
